# “From Hair To There”™

## Hair play doll features:

- Hair that grows! Top portion of hair can be extended to add extra volume to hairdos.

### • **Knob Mechanism:**

Push to release extra hair.  
Turn knob to reel the hair back in.

- Knob is located on the doll's back.

• Hairplay is so much fun!  
We suggest keeping the original hairgrow braids to help avoid any tangles in the mechanism.

- Extra long hair (and lots of it!)
- Sun-kissed highlights

# "Crown Braid"

## Step 1

Sweep hair to one side except for one  $\frac{3}{4}$ -inch section from underneath. Clip on hair extension to the base of the strand, hiding the felt piece. Take the loose side and split it into 3 strands, mixing the extension and the doll's hair.



## Step 2

Use the 3 strands to create a simple braid. Take the right section and cross it over the middle section. The right section is now the middle section. Now take the left section and cross it over the middle section. Repeat until you have a braid.



## Step 3

Bring the braid over the doll's head and secure the braid in place with bobby pins. Sweep the rest of the doll's hair back into place.





# "Twisted Heart"

## Step 1

Take a 1 inch section of hair from each side of doll's head and tie them together into a ponytail with an elastic. Grab a second 1 inch section of hair just below the first ones.



## Step 2

Roll the second strand of hair over the first section and pull it through the loop created between the 2 sections.



## Step 3

Repeat step 2 on the other side. Tie the three long ends together with an elastic.





# "Flower Bun"

## Step 1

Make a half ponytail and secure it with an elastic. Attach the hair ribbon to the elastic.



## Step 2

Split the ponytail into 3 equal parts (including the hair ribbon strips). Make a braid then secure it with an elastic at the end.



## Step 3

Twirl the braid in a circle and secure it with bobby pins, making sure to hide the end of the braid.





# "Feather Braids"

## Step 1

Using small sections of hair, make tight little braids. Do this all around doll's head. Secure braids with elastic at the end.



## Step 2

Slightly pull out small loops of hair from the braid, using your fingers or a comb.



## Step 3

Continuing along the braid, repeat step 2 every  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch, leaving sections of the braid in between untouched to create a pattern.



**ATTENTION:** Avoid wetting the doll's head or body to prevent mold. Dry the doll at room temperature if her hair or body are wet. Do not use a blow dryer.
