Knob Mechanism:

Push to release extra hair. Turn knob to reel the hair back in.

- Knob is located on the doll's back.
- Hairplay is so much fun!
 We suggest keeping the original hairgrow braids to help avoid any tangles in the mechanism.
- Extra long hair (and lots of it!)
- Sun-kissed highlights

"Crown Braid"

Step 1

Sweep hair to one side except for one ¾ -inch section from underneath. Clip on hair extension to the base of the strand, hiding the felt piece. Take the loose side and split it into 3 strands, mixing the extension and the doll's hair.



Use the 3 strands to create a simple braid. Take the right section and cross it over the middle section. The right section is now the middle section. Now take the left section and cross it over the middle section. Repeat until you have a braid.













Step 1

Using small sections of hair, make tight little braids. Do this all around doll's head. Secure braids with elastic at the end.

Step 2

Slightly pull out small loops of hair from the braid, using your fingers or a comb.

Step 3

Continuing along the braid, repeat step 2 every ¾ inch, leaving sections of the braid in between untouched to create a pattern.



ATTENTION: Avoid wetting the doll's head or body to prevent mold. Dry the doll at room temperature if her hair or body are wet. Do not use a blow dryer.
